MEETING MINUTES

- The Kuhar Park Advisory Board meeting was called to order by acting Chair Steve Flaig at 6:50 PM on July 6, 2015.
- The previous meeting minutes were reviewed. Ron Kelsey made the motion to approve the minutes as sent, seconded by Justin Thram and approved.
- Justin Thram discussed tree removal and it was learned that Keck has more jobs than he can handle but will continue with the tree removal in the park. The next cleanup day was scheduled for Wednesday, July 22<sup>nd</sup>, weather permitting. Ron Kelsey suggested that the pile of logs in the park should be removed as soon as possible because of safety reasons. The back shelter will be painted that evening.
- Brian Pfarr continues to work on the dock and push those involved to work on this project.
- Bob Krinke announced that the Lions Club donated an additional \$10,000 for the park from the gambling fund.
- Brian Pfarr and Justin Thram updated the committee on the upcoming Corn and Hamburger Feed. Their next meeting is at 6:30 on Monday, July 20<sup>th</sup> at the Legion. There will be a donation booth at the feed and if all future costs are totaled, a thermometer of need costs will be prepared by Clayton Hubert. At this time the feasibility of purchased land costs is not known. In kind information will not be included on this thermometer. Ron Kelsey and Bob Krinke are working on this sign. A large park plan will also be drawn up if the land purchase is formulated. The Sanborn Fire Department could be asked to provide a tent for the Sweet Corn feed.
- Brian Pfarr will communicate further with Leon Benedict on the possibility of acquiring two acres of land on the parks north side.
- Ron Kelsey will contact the Minnesota Charitable Gambling Board for information on the ducks.
- The trail was discussed with Justin Thram to stake it out and mow the trail for the time being. It will be designated by the time of the Sweet Corn feed. In another year we will discuss shrubbery for the sightline of the trail.
- Steve Flaig reported on the Kuhar Park Abstract and the letter from Attorney Matthew Muske is included with the minutes.
- Bob Krinke will contact John Rogotzke about building the shelf for the middle shelter. Construction repair is still needed for the front shelter and Ron Kelsey was asked to not

contact Bruce Olson for the front shelter shelf as it will not be needed for the Sweet Corn Feed.

- Was someone contacting Swede from Sanborn for use of tables for the Sweet Corn feed?
- Ron Kelsey announced that the money from the 91<sup>st</sup> annual Community Rummage Sale will go to Kuhar Park this year. The sale normally nets \$2,000. The park committee members were asked to help with the sale by picking up items placed on the curb on Saturday September 26<sup>th</sup>. The sale will be in the Community Center on October 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- The next meeting was scheduled for August 3<sup>rd</sup> at 7:00 PM.
- The meeting was adjourned.
