

ORDINANCE No. 102

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING BIENNIAL ELECTION SYSTEM

The City Council of Lambertton, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. Pursuant to M.S.A. 412.022 (Laws 1973, Ch. 34, Sec. 3) commencing with the 1974 city election, the regular city election of Lambertton shall be held biennially on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of every even-numbered year.

Section 2. Commencing with the first regular biennial election, the terms for the offices of mayor shall be two years, and councilman shall be four years.

Section 3. The terms of incumbent elective officers expiring in January, following a year in which there is no city election shall be extended one year.

Section 4. This ordinance repeals Ordinance No. 84 and all other inconsistent ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take affect upon its passage and publication.
