

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING EXHIBITION OPERATION OF A MOTOR VEHICLE IN THE CITY OF LAMBERTON, REDWOOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

The Council of the City of Lamberton ordains:

SECTION 1. No person shall operate any vehicle in such a manner as to create or cause unnecessary engine noise, tire squealing, skid or slide upon acceleration or stopping, or in such a manner as to simulate a race or temporary race or to cause such vehicle to unnecessarily sway or turn abruptly or to impede traffic.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$300.00 or imprisonment for not to exceed 90 days or both.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE PROHIBITING EXHIBITION OPERATION OF A MOTOR
VEHICLE IN THE CITY OF LAMBERTON, REDWOOD COUNTY, MINNESOTA, AND
PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Council of the City of Lambertton does ordain:

1. That Section 2 of the ordinance prohibiting exhibition operation of a motor vehicle
in the City of Lambertton, Redwood County, Minnesota, and providing penalties for the
violation thereof be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

"Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be
deemed to be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall
be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00."
