

ORDINANCE NO. 127

BEING AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF THE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 633 SWIMMING POOL AND GROUNDS, PROHIBITING THE UNAUTHORIZED USE THEREOF, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION OF ITS PROVISIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAMBERTON DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1. Definitions.

a. "Swimming Pool Grounds" means the bathhouse and swimming pool located on the following described property located in the County of Redwood, State of Minnesota, more particularly described as:

Commencing at a point of where the North line of Fifth Street in the Village of Lambertton extended Easterly intersects the street line of Section 23, Township 109 North of Range 37 West, Fifth Principal Meridian running thence Easterly along the North line of said Fifth Street as so extended to a point 600 feet due East of said center line of said Section 23 thence due South and parallel with said center line of said Section 23 and 600 feet distant therefrom to a point on the North line of the public road extending Easterly as established and laid out along the Southerly boundary line of said Village of Lambertton thence Westerly along the North line of said public road 600 feet to said center line thence Northerly along said center line to the point of beginning containing 23.37 acres more or less according to survey

including the premises immediately contiguous to the swimming pool and adjoining the bathhouse which are enclosed from time to time by a chain link fence.

b. "School Board" means the governing body of Independent School District No. 633.

Section 2. Days and Hours of Operation. Swimming pool grounds shall be open to the general public on those days and hours established by the School Board from time to time by resolution and shall be open to other groups or individuals on days and at times specifically approved by the School Board.

The hours and days the swimming pool grounds are open to the general public shall be posted near the entrance to the swimming pool grounds and any other conspicuous locations designated by the School Board.

Section 3. Violations. Any person on swimming pool grounds on days or at times when the swimming pool grounds are not open to the general public and without specific approval of the School Board shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
