

ORDINANCE NUMBER 139

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS SALARIES

THE CITY OF LAMBERTON DOES ORDAIN:


Section 1. As per new City Code (laws 1973, Chapter 123), salaries may be changed without the possibility of an election on the question, and new salaries become effective following the next local election. This change in law is a result of the fact that Article II, Section 4 of the City Code law repealed Minnesota Statutes 412.181, and Article V, Section I codified as 412.017 explicitly makes Minnesota Statutes 415.11 applicable to all statutory cities after January 1, 1974.

Section 2. As pursuant to law, the new salary of the Mayor shall be \$1,750.00 per year and that of the Councilmembers shall be \$1,000.00 per year each. In addition to the fixed yearly salary, the Mayor and Councilmembers shall each receive \$40.00 per special meeting .

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed on the effective date of this Ordinance.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective on January 1, after the next succeeding municipal election.
