

ORDINANCE NO. 95

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING CAMPING REGULATIONS; CURFEW; PROMOTING THE GENERAL WELFARE FOR KUHAR PARK AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

The council of the Village of Lamberton ordains:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to be present in or upon any public grounds within the confines of Kuhar Park between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. unless said person is engaged in camping with bona fide camping equipment.


SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in any loud or boisterous conduct which does or is likely to disturb or anger any person or to assemble to carry out any purpose in such a manner as to disturb the public peace.

SECTION 3. Every person camping within the said Kuhar Park with bona fide camping equipment shall secure a permit from the Village Clerk or a Village Police Officer.

SECTION 4. Any person violating provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the County jail for not more than 90 days.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.

AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 95, AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING CAMPING

The Council of the City of Lambertton does ordain:

1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 95 be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

" Any person violating provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty
misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of
not more than \$100.00."
