Mandatory Service Line, Sump Pump & Water Meter Audit Inspection

Dear City of Lamberton Water Service Customer,

The City of Lamberton will be going door to door to inspect for lead water service lines, sump pumps and water meters starting April 15, 2019.

The Minnesota Department of Health in conjunction with the Environmental Protection Agency continually research the safety of drinking water and are currently preparing for additional water infrastructure needs by developing a new funding mechanism for the replacement of lead service lines. This would include lines on private property.

As part of the inspection, sump pumps and meters will be checked for ordinance compliance. The City of Lamberton is regulated by the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency on the amount of water entering the sewer system and is subject to incompliant penalties.

If you would prefer to schedule a time for the inspection, please call City Hall at (507)752-7601 or email mpeterson@lambertonmn.com. We ask you to allow an appointment to accommodate a two-hour time span.

To be in compliance with the audit inspection:

- The City of Lamberton will need to gain access to the water meter inside your home or business.
- The sump pump and water meter area should be clear and accessible.
- An adult 18 years old or older must be present during the inspection.
- The inspection should take no longer than ½ hour.
